ABA MEN & WOMEN LAYTON CUP BOXING MEET – 2008

(Selection trails for Women boxers for the Asian Women Championships - India)

1. **Dates, Venue and Time**

On 14th, 15th, and 16th of July 2008 at Sugathadasa Indoor Stadium, Colombo 13 commencing at 4.45 pm on each day.

2. **Rules of the Competition**

The meet will be conducted according to the 2008 AIBA rules.

3. **Weight Categories**

4. **Eligibility**

This meet is open to all male & female boxers who are over 17 years and below 34 years. A boxer's age is determined on the first day of the competition. This age will be effective throughout the tournament if a boxer has a birthday during the competition. Only those boxers who have qualified to take part in major meets before or Winners/Runners up at the ABA Novices, Intermediates, Stubbs Shield and winners of Junior Nationals are qualified take part in this meet. **Proof of achievement** MUST be entered in the entry form with the year of participation. **NO FRESHERS WILL BE PERMITTED TO ENTER.**

5. **Rounds and Duration**

Each bout for men will consist of four rounds of two minutes each with one minute interval between them. Each bout for women will consist of three rounds of two minutes each with a one minute interval between them,

6. **Dress**

- a. **Clothing.** -Competitors shall box in light boots or shoes without any spikes and without any heels, socks, shorts not to exceed knee length. Boxers shall wear either a red or blue singlet, depending on the colour of their corner, which shall be their own responsibility. Female boxers may wear short- sleeved T-shirt beneath their vest.
- b. **Cup Protectors & Gum Shield** - All competitors should have their own cup protectors and Gum shields. Women boxers may have their own breast protectors (not compulsory).
- c. **Head Guards** - The use of Red/Blue Head Guards shall be mandatory. The ABA will provide them.

d. During Weigh in - The male boxers should weigh with his swimming suit or under wear on. If necessary he can take his underwear off on the scale only.

7. **Gloves & Bandages**

- a. Only 10 oz (284 Gms) gloves will be used and they will be provided by the ABA.
- b. Only soft surgical or 'Velpau' bandaging not longer than 2.5 m and 5.7 cm wide on each hand should be used.

8. **Prohibited Objects**

- a. No other objects may be worn during the competition. The use of pure Vaseline rubbed into the forehead and eyebrow to prevent an injury is permitted. The use of Vintogeno, grease, Vaseline or products that are likely to be harmful or objectionable to the opponent, on the face, arms or any part of the body is forbidden.
- b. A boxer shall be clean-shaven before the Weigh-in. Beards are not allowed. Only a thin moustache not exceeding the length of the upper lip is allowed.

9. **Medical Examination – Weigh-in and draw**

The preliminary weigh-in preceded by the medical examination will be held on Monday the **14th July 2008** between 8.00 to 10.00 am at the Sugathadasa Indoor Stadium. The Medical examination and weigh-in on **15th and 16th July 2008** will be held from 8.00 to 9.00 am at the same venue. The draw will commence after the weigh-in. **ALL COMPETITORS MUST COMPLETE THE MEDICAL CERTIFICATE ON PAGE 2, 3, 4, 5 AND ALSO ANNUAL MEDICAL EXAMINATION ON PAGE 22 OF THEIR MEDICAL BOOKS, SIGNED BY A MBBS QUALIFIED DOCTOR.** Failing to produce this will be an automatically disqualification. In addition female boxers shall furnish all the information required as to their physical condition and conform with their signature the correctness of the statements prior to the weigh in.

10. **Registration**

It is mandatory to produce the national ID card and recently taken passport size photograph to register the new medical books. (Attached form is required to fill and hand over to get a medical Book)

11. **Entries**

ENTRIES CLOSE ON 30th of June 2008. They should be sent to Hony Secretary ABA at the address given above in the specified form along with a medical certificate obtained from a Western qualified doctor. Late entries will not be accepted.

12. **Entry Fees**

A club can enter any number of boxers if they fulfill the eligibility of this meet. An Entry Fee of Rs.50.00 per competitor should be paid to the Hony Treasurer before the draw on 14th July 2008.

13. **Awards**

All winners, runners up and semi finalist will receive medals and certificates. The best male boxer of Layton Cup Meet will receive the Admiral Sir Jeffery Layton Cup.
